**Assembly** Instructions





View of completed model \* This model was designed for Papercraft and may differ from the original in some respects.

## Assembly tip

- Write the number of each part on the reverse side of the part in pencil upon cutting it out, to be sure you can tell which part is which later.
- ■Before gluing, crease the paper along mountain and valley fold lines. Trace along the folds with a ruler and an exhausted ballpoint pen (out of ink) to get a sharper fold.
- Make sure rounded sections are nice and stiff.

## **Tools**

- Scissors
- Ruler, set square
- Glue (Wood glue or craft glue recommend)
- Exhausted ballpoint pen (out of ink)
- Toothpicks (for use in applying glue)
- Tweezers (useful for handling small parts)
- Pencil

## Key to symbols

Mountain fold Fold so that the printed pattern faces outside. Dots indicate parts to be glued; Dotted line dotted lines indicate approximate area for application of glue. Valley fold Fold so that the printed pattern faces inside. Dashed and Red dot dotted line Glue parts with the same number together. Cut a notch Cut along the center of the line along this line. Green dot Glue areas within the same part together. Solid line Blue dot Glue to the reverse side of the specified part. Cut a notch Cut these areas out. Blue star Glue reverse side to reverse side of other part. Scissors mark

■ Assembly Instructions: Six A4 sheets (No. 1 to No. 6) Build this model with careful reference to the Assembly Instructions.
